 - Meida is tested according to Clo-values.

 - Although Meida is lighter than down
 - vigorous tests have proven it to be the better insulator.
 - Meida is extremely breathable for superior comfort.

Where to use Meida?

- Open-structured fabrics, like wool.
 You have no fibermigration and will at the same time achieve a windbreaking effect.
- All kind of garments for active people, sport, leisure or professional.
 The construction allows transport of sweat... just like underwear for skiing.
- Footwear and gloves, as well as hats
- Childrens wear, very suited for outdoor playsuits.
- Sleepingbags, blankets, mattresses etc.
